## GENERAL AND ADVISORY COMMITTEES

### FINANCE COMMITTEE-

- 1. Discussion regarding sales and profit margin for the month of November, the first quarter, and budget; Fiscal YTD shows profit of \$114K; Profit margin for November is 7.8%.
- 2. Noted: TSBS (Laura Smith) is officially under contract for monthly maintenance as needed to assist with accounting and QBO.
- 3. Discussion of 1st quarter distributions.
  - MOTION: Prepare and distribute 1st quarter distributions- Approved Unanimously.
- 4. Discussion to purchase a shed for outside in dumpster area; Shed is @\$4.7K. MOTION: To approve shed purchase and installation- Approved Unanimously.

## PERSONNEL COMMITTEE-

- Discussion for the use of Catapult as an HR resource.
   MOTION: To approve the purchase of Catapult at @2.7K; Approved Unanimously.
- 2. The Personnel Committee will evaluate GM Brady quarterly on his performance for the purpose of quarterly salary increases.

### PUBLIC COMMENTS

# Presentation by Police Chief Thompson:

- Chief Thompson discussed the upcoming construction of the new Police Station and needs for future recruitment.
- Chair Bishop met with Chief Thompson prior to the Board meeting to discuss financial needs of the Angier Police Department.
- Chair Bishop expressed concern the statutory obligation was not received by the PD via the town.

 Chair Bishop noted the statutory obligation allocated through the town is not enough to assist the Angier Police Department with technological updates.

 Chair Bishop expressed a desire to give \$80K to the Angier Police Department above and beyond our statutory requirement; These funds would be to upgrade PD technology; These funds could be distributed on a quarterly basis (4 installments of 20K).

Chair Bishop and Chief Thompson suggested the Town create a line item

specifically for this additional donation for distributive clarity.

**MOTION:** Proposal to give \$80K over upcoming calendar year pending Logistics—Approved Unanimously.

## Comments by Mr. Gaylan Bishop:

- Mr. Bishop informed Board of his recent Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for all current FY Financials, Budget, and Budget vs Actuals comparison.
- Mr. Bishop informed the Board and GM of his concerns regarding Budget management and reporting practices from the standpoint of a concerned citizen, desiring more efficient stewardship of his money being spent.
- Mr. Bishop expressed a need for clarity on budget management.
- Mr. Bishop offered a comparison to his own budget management requirements and practices used at his previous employer as a guideline for Angier ABC improvement.
